## National Survey for President Bush and The United States Congress Concerning Homeland Security and America's Open Border Crisis

*Citizen Guardian* is polling community leaders concerning steps our government must take to secure America's borders to stop illegal entry into America and the growing criminal and terrorist threat to homeland security.

A report on this survey's findings will then be delivered to every member of Congress, President Bush, his key advisors, and the news media. Everyone who participates in this survey will also receive a copy of the final survey report.

The purpose of this survey is to show Congress, President Bush and America's political leaders that the great majority of Americans are alarmed and angry at our government's failure to enforce existing laws against illegal immigration, which leaves America so vulnerable to terrorist attack due to lax border security and easy entry by criminals and terrorists into the U.S.

Most immediately, *Citizen Guardian* will use the results of this survey to pressure Congress to significantly increase and improve all aspects of America's border security – especially with Mexico from which 3,000,000 illegal aliens slip across the border into America every year.

We also expect this survey to show Congress that the American people want the border with Canada secured, where al Qaeda cells now operate relatively freely due to Canada's extremely lax immigration laws and weak commitment to the war on terror. Clearly we need far more than the 500 border control agents patrolling the more than 6,000 miles of our border with Canada.

## National Survey for President Bush and The United States Congress Concerning Homeland Security and America's Open Border Crisis

- 1) **Issue Summary:** Of the three million new illegal aliens crossing the Mexican border every year, it is estimated that 190,000 of them are from countries other than Mexico. These intruders coming mainly across the Mexican border include people from such terrorist-producing nations as **Afghanistan, Iran, Iraq, Egypt, Sudan, Bulgaria, Indonesia, India, China and Russia**.

**QUESTION:** In your view, how likely is it that some of these illegal aliens coming across the Mexican border are **al Qaeda** or other terrorist operatives determined to detonate **Weapons of Mass Destruction** inside the United States?

- 2) **Issue Summary:** Only 500 border control agents now patrol the U.S. border with Canada (compared to 9,000 U.S. border control agents along the Mexican border). The U.S. Canadian border includes thousands of miles of forest, water and mountains, often without a single law enforcement official (or person of any kind) for as far as the eye can see. A terrorist can just walk across the Canadian border undetected. Because Canada's immigration laws are lax, al Qaeda can easily establish itself in Canada. In addition, Canada has shown little interest in the U.S. war on terror, and al Qaeda cells may be able to operate undetected in Canada without much concern for law enforcement. According to news reports, al Qaeda is actively trying to obtain radiological material for the purpose of building a dirty nuclear bomb which it plans to transport from Canada and detonate in the United States.

**QUESTION:** How serious a threat do you think al Qaeda's Canadian operation is to the United States?

- 3) **QUESTION:** President Bush is asking Congress to offer Temporary Work Visas to the 8-13 million illegal aliens now living in the United States, a form of amnesty for those already illegally in the U.S. Do you think granting Amnesty is more likely to encourage or discourage additional illegal immigration and threats to the security of the United States?

- Granting Amnesty to America's illegal aliens is far more likely to encourage more illegal immigration into the U.S and threats to homeland security.

- 4) **Issue Summary:** Surveys show that about 80% of Americans want tighter border security. Surveys also show a majority of immigrants who are living here legally also strongly oppose granting Amnesty for illegal aliens.

- 5) **Issue Summary:** The U.S. uses the National Guard to patrol America's airports, but not for 8,000 miles of our open borders. The U.S. Border Control is severely under-manned —only about 10,000 total border control agents who night and day must stop illegal crossings and organized criminal & terrorist activity across this huge expanse.

**QUESTION:** Would you support legislation that would allow our National Guard to patrol America's borders?

- 6) **Issue Summary:** The Mexican government is doing very little to discourage or stop border crossings into the United States and puts the physical and financial burden on America to stem the tide of criminals, gangs and terrorists illegally crossing the border. Estimates indicated the U.S. can build a security fence along its 1,951 mile border with Mexico for a cost of about \$5.5 billion. This would amount to just 0.8% of the U.S. defense budget for one year. Such a security fence would also be a significant help to America's under-manned border control agents.

**QUESTION:** Should the U.S. build such a relatively inexpensive security fence along the Mexican border to stop the flood of illegal immigration, even if that means angering the Mexican government?
